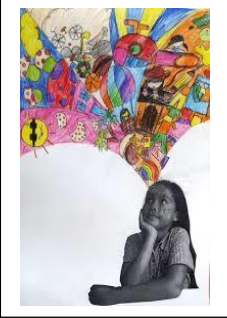


Year 6 Homework – World War Two

Collage

Use a range of different materials to create a collage representing a soldier's experience during the war. Think about the background of your picture as well as the soldier's expression.

Uniform Design

Fashion designer Hugo Boss designed the Nazi uniform. Have a go at designing your own British Army, Air Force and Navy uniforms.



Gas Masks

During the war, everyone was issued with a gas mask to protect them from gas bombs, which could be dropped during air raids. Create your own, and its box, using junk modelling.

Cooking – Eggless Cake

Ingredients

1/2 pint of tea (without any milk or tea leaves/bags)
3oz butter/margarine
3oz sugar
3oz sultanas
10oz wholewheat flour (add 3-4 teaspoons of baking powder)
1 teaspoon of all spice (mixed spice) – extra cinnamon, if required

Method

1. Add the tea, sugar, butter and sultanas into a saucepan. Heat gently until the butter has melted and then leave it to cool.
2. Mix all of the dry ingredients together.
3. Add and mix the dry ingredients into the cooled liquid. Beat the mixture well.
4. Grab a 7-inch cake tin and grease it. Put the mixture into it.
5. Cook on 180°C degrees for around 45 minutes.
6. Serve and enjoy!

Anne is famous for her diaries which she kept whilst living in an annex during the war. Her family was Jewish and needed to hide from the Nazi's. Create your own version of Anne's diaries, documenting the events of the war from a Jewish perspective.
